



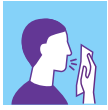
Instructions for Patients with COVID-19 and Their Sitters



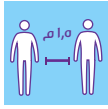
- Clean hands with soap and water for 40-60 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% of alcohol for 20-30 seconds.



- Avoid touching eyes, mouth or nose before washing your hands.



- Use paper tissues to cover mouth and nose when sneezing or coughing, immediately discard used tissues in a closed trash and wash hands. If tissues are unavailable, use upper arm to cover mouth and nose.



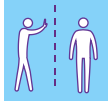
- Adhere to the rules of social distancing by keeping at least 1.5 meters between you and others.



- Wear a surgical face mask, if you have respiratory symptoms such as coughing or sneezing.



- Refrain from greeting people using handshaking, hugs or kisses.



- It is prohibited to go outside the room or visit other patients.



- Maintain personal hygiene.



- Adhere to the medical team instructions.

Sitter permission may be granted according to the patient's status and after the treating physician's evaluation. If a sitter is allowed to stay, adhering to the previous and following instructions is required:



- Wear the necessary protective equipment, according to the medical team instructions "surgical face mask, gloves and gown", while being inside the patient's room.



- The sitter should not leave the room unless urgently needed. If permitted by the nurse, he/she shall wear a surgical face mask and perform hand hygiene.

For the safety of our patients, families and health care workers, a sitter may not be granted permission to stay with the patient.
