Storage of Patient Specific Multi-Dose Medication

## Isolation and Regular Patients

### WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT

- No medication is allowed to be stored inside the patient's room at any time.
- All patient-specific multi-dose medication for isolated and regular patients must be stored in the patient-specific bin inside the Medication Room.
- For isolated patients: medication must be placed in a zip-lock plastic bag and wiped before taking it out of the patient's room to be stored back in the patient-specific bin inside the Medication Room.
- The CIPP has been updated and under approval process in Navex.
